



Installing Versions of Hog 3PC on Windows Vista



The installation of Hog3PC on Windows Vista is enabled in software versions 3.0.0 and greater. Some installation and operational problems could occur depending upon certain Windows Vista settings.

Installation Quits Unexpectedly

In some instances, the Hog3PC installer may unexpectedly quit during installation on Windows Vista with the following message:

The installer has encountered an unexpected error installing this package. This may indicate a problem with this package. The error code is 2738.

This is because the Microsoft Windows VBScript may not be registered within Windows Vista. To enable the VBScript engine, follow these steps:

1. On the **Start** menu, click **Run**.
2. In the "Open" field, enter the following command and click OK:
`regsvr32 vbscript.dll`
3. A message should appear stating that the "DllRegisterServer in C:\WINDOWS\system32\vbscript.dll succeeded."
4. Click **OK** and try installing Hog3PC again.

Note: You must be logged in to Windows as the administrator or as a user with administrator privileges for the step above.

“Unknown Exception” when running Hog 3PC after installation

We recommend turning off Vista "User Access Control" in Windows Control Panel/User Accounts.

If you wish to leave UAC on, right click on the Hog 3PC shortcut and select "**Run as Administrator**".
